

### Full-time senior clinician position announcement

The Emergency and Critical Care department of the Small Animal Veterinary University Hospital of Alfort (Masons Alfort, close to Paris, FRANCE) offers a position for a **full time senior clinician** in small animal emergency and critical care, starting January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023 (starting date is negotiable).

**If you are EVECC diplomate or EVECC eligible this position may interest, you.**

Salary and rank will be commensurate with academic credentials and experience.

The successful candidate will join the VECC hospital team to strengthen and develop the ECC department, which includes an emergency service (ES) and critical/intensive care unit (ICU). The referral Veterinary University Hospital of Alfort offers state of the art facilities and equipment (24/7 ES and ICU, consulting rooms, medium care, general and specialized surgery rooms, endoscopy, ultrasonography, digital X-ray, CT-scan, soon an MRI ...) with multiple diplomates of EBVS Colleges.

The VECC team is a young and dynamic clinical team, it is dedicated both to small animal care and to rotational internship and student education. This team is composed by one full professor ECVECC diplomate, one clinician ECVECC board eligible, six full time VECC dedicated young veterinarian clinicians and seven vet-technicians.

The emergency service admits 5 000 cases per year (about 40 percent in referral or second opinion) and the critical/intensive care unit hospitalizes around 2 000 small animals per year.

In accordance to VECC standards, the ER/ICU department is well equipped, with twenty-two care cages for dogs and cats including vital monitoring devices, infusion/syring pumps and oxygen. ER/ICU department has 24/7 access to hospital equipment and has also point of care biochemical, electrolytes, coagulation and haematological analysers, two portable ultrasounds, hemodialysis, two mechanical ventilators, high flow oxygen devices, defibrillator, etc. ER/ICU department has its own 24/7 blood bank for dogs and cats.

The National Veterinary School of Alfort, AEEEV accredited, is located in the south east of Paris and offers a 10-hectare site with very warm and intimate atmosphere with lots of green and lush area in the city. Paris is the capital of France and offers all great town facilities: parks, art museums, theatres, and restaurants.
